- ☯ The ***Core Principle*** of the Libertarian Party is compatible with the ***Ten Key Values*** of the Greens.
- ☯ The left-wing pull on Greens and the right-wing pull on Libertarians have caused both parties to betray their core principles and values.
- ☯ Greens and Libertarians could become a potent force for freedom, equality, progress, and respect for the earth by returning to core principles and values.
- ☯ Greens and Libertarians remain unable to prevent wars of conquest, corporate welfare, runaway bureaucracy, rape of the commons and the general erosion of freedom and justice.

He was also the Allegheny County Chair, first of the Greens and then of the Libertarian Party.
